English Services



Celebrate Recovery used the new space to bake about 500 Christmas cookies to donate to our church missions outreach program.

Celebrate recovery

Celebrate recovery now has an attendance of 100 people weekly! We had a very blessed year. Two leaders left the program, but even so, the Lord has provided and the ministry is expanding. The monthly attendance in November was 411 people. Praise the Lord with us for this group of honesty people that openly state the need of Jesus in areas of their lives that need recovery!

Please pray that the two leaders, who left, would be replaced. This last year was one of the most challenging years we ever faced. Pray with us that the Lord of the Harvest would send the workers for his harvest.

2. Pray with us for the following needs:

1. Personal and vibrant relationship with the Lord, we believe to be the true ground for an honest presentation of Jesus' good news.
2. English services at both churches. Pray that they would provide the people who attend biblical English fluency, (the English schools they attend, bible terms are not taught) and specially presenting the unbelievers with the Gospel message.
3. Celebrate Recovery training for 2012. We need about 10 new group leaders, 5 men's and 5 women's to coordinate the alcohol, drug, sex, physical and emotional abuse and codependency groups. Our first leadership training section will be on February the 5th. We would really appreciate your prayers; leadership training is the key for the program's growth.
4. For the Lord's protection. We have sensed the spiritual battle in a much stronger degree as the strongholds of addictions are been broken in so many lives from Celebrate Recovery. In twenty one years of ministry in Brazil, our home was broken into twice this last year. The last time, was last week when we were already in the USA. There was nothing of high financial value for the robbers to take away! Please, continue to pray for protection for our home and our lives.
5. That the Lord would continue to provide for our financial needs during this furlough and back in Brazil during this difficult world financial crisis.
