

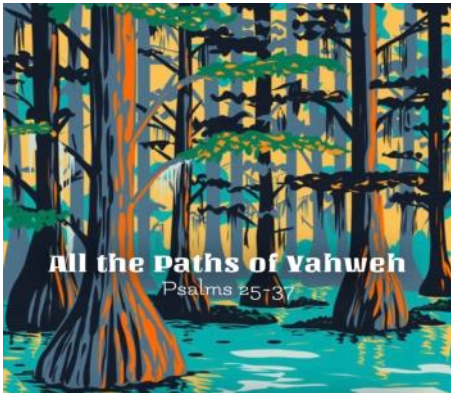

he is to be feared above all gods.

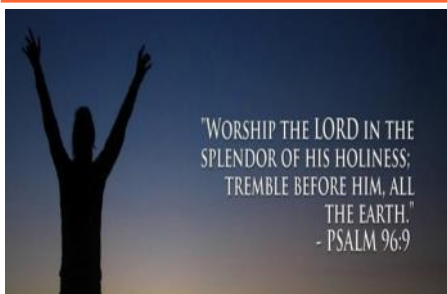

The buzz of school is back this week. May the buzz of His people declaring His glory never cease nor take a summer break.

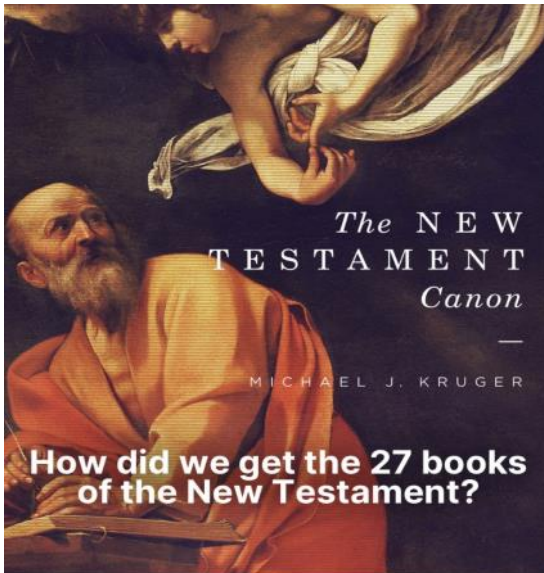
